Course structure

Year 1

In your first year, you'll study eight units in the Diploma of Business. These subjects will provide you with a strong grounding in basic technical, theoretical, and practical knowledge that will set you on the path to a Monash business degree.

Year 2

In your second year, you'll study six core business units and two academic-skills based units that are designed to prepare you for direct transition into one of the accountancy, or non-accountancy majors of the Bachelor of Business and Commerce degree.

Prerequisites

Credit in Mathematics: Australian Year 11 equivalent.

English: Monash's minimum requirements apply. The following English proficiency tests are accepted:

- IELTS (Academic)/IELTS One Skill Retake (Academic)/IELTS Online – Overall band score of 5.5 with no band less than 5.0
- TOEFL iBT/TOEFL iBT Paper Edition² – A total score of 46 with 14 in Writing and Speaking, and 4 in Listening and Reading
- Pearson Test of English (Academic)² – Overall score of 47 with no Communicative Skills lower than 36
- C1 Advanced/C2 Proficiency² – Overall score of 162 with no skill score lower than 154

Tests must be taken within 24 months prior to course commencement.
